

Result of MT "G.Lkhagvasuren-60"

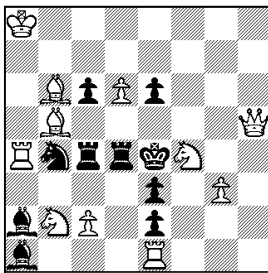
The Mongolian sports newspaper "Tavan tsagarig" (Five rings) has announced in 2009 the Memorial Tourney "G.Lkhagvasuren-60" (1949-2006) for #3 problems with a third-pin.

12 authors from 6 countries on competition have sent 15 problems: I.Agapov (Russia-3), E.Bogdanov (Ukraine-1), G.Bor (Mongolia-1), V.Chernyh (Russia-1), A.Chistyakov (Latvia-2), S.Enkhtuvshin (Mongolia-1), E.Fomichev (Russia-1), A.Gasparyan (Armenia-1), R.Larin (Russia-1), V.Melnikov (Ukraine-1), Ts.Ser-Od (Mongolia-1), J.Simadhinata (Indonesia-1). Some problems were not thematic or with duals different character. The preliminary result has been put on a site www.selivanov.ru {link -<http://www.selivanov.ru/download/Awards/Drugie/2009/MTL60Pr.pdf>} and sent participants in the beginning of November, 2009.

During discussion of a preliminary result from participants of competition some remarks concerning I.Agapov and E.Fomichev problems have arrived, and in view of presence of partial predecessors (the appendix see) it was necessary to lower their estimations to special distinction.

Thematic game is realised in 4 variants against two pairs interchange of the second and third white moves! A beautiful try with thematic game in two variants, triple change of game on additional defence 1... Tc3 and game change in three variants (1... Sd5/S:c2, 1... T:c2, 1... Tc3) put forward this problem in numbers of classical works.

Vladimir Melnikov (I Hon.Men.) - A interesting problem with the rare form third-pin with three pawns on a vertical line. 4 mating moves in pairs on one thematic defence in three variants make cyclic change (ABC-BCA).

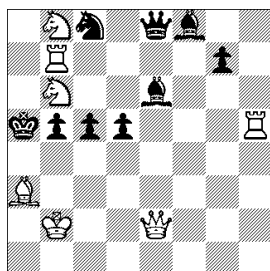

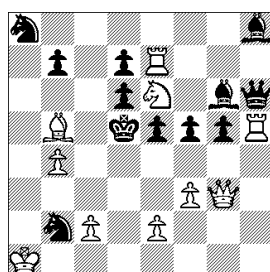
